Over the past several weeks we have been busy with various lectureships. In about a three week period we had four lectureships here on the mission. Each lectureship was aimed at particular group of people thus the reason for four lectureships. We started with a lectureship for preachers followed by a lectureship for young ladies, a lectureship for older ladies and then we concluded with a lectureship for those who had completed the Bible correspondence courses we send out. Overall we were very pleased with the lectureships and we had some of the best attendance we have had for sometime.

The Chimala School of Preaching is back in secession after about a months break. This quarter I have picked up two classes, the Parables of Christ and the Preachers Life and Work in Evangelism. We have only had two class periods thus far but all seems to going well and the students seem to be learning.

Over the last few days we have been working with a congregation near to the mission called Mbuyuni. The congregation has been in existence for about fourteen years, the congregation is made up of about 15 to 20 faithful Christians mostly young in age. The preacher's name is Peter Njoyo a graduate of our three month Bible program. Peter seems to be doing a good work with this congregation. We worked there with the congregation for a total of four days. During that period of time classes were taught over being the best congregation we can be. Also we spent some time going house to house. We had a total of five baptisms and six restorations. As you might imagine we were all excited with the outcome of the work there.
